

## Bike Service - Checklist Basics.

- Adjust and lube chain. Check split pins have been replaced.
- Clean and re-oil air filter
- Re – fuel
- Lube moving parts i.e. foot peg pivots, levers, kick starter pivot, brake and gear lever pivots, and cables if needed.
- Check tyre pressures. Usually between 12 and 18psi depending on conditions. Use lower pressures on muddy days and higher pressures if ground is hard and rocky.
- Check steering head bearings and wheel bearings for movement. Replace bearings once movement is detected. The scrutineers can help you with detecting movement if unsure.
- Check over and tighten any loose nuts and bolts.
- Keep your bike clean, this assists in detecting problems and servicing of your bike.
